



Job Title: Indigenous Driving Instructor

## Job Summary:

The North Island Driving School is currently seeking another driving instructor to train new drivers on the rules of the road and safe driving practices. - 4. Ability to work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends, if necessary.
- 5. Must have a clean driving record.
